# THURSDAY, JUNE 20, 2019 MINUTES OF MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### INTRODUCTORY MATTERS

- 1. Welcome guests and members of the public. The meeting convened at 5:00 p.m.
- 2. Roll call; establish a quorum; call Public Hearing and Special Called Meeting to order; declare them open to the public.

Directors Present: Jarrod Reynolds, Tracy Mesler, Tim Watts, Shannon Nave, Richard English and Mike Berkley

Director Absent: Don Majka and Brent Wilson

3. Pledges of allegiance to the flags were recited.

### PUBLIC HEARING

- 1. Director Nave moved to approve a request to amend an approved new well application and an application for exception to District spacing requirements submitted by City of Willow Park in Parker County with the following conditions: (1) once selected, the well drilling contractor must complete and sign the portion of the applications related to well driller; (2) an electric/geophysical log shall be completed related to the well, and the applicant will submit all such logs to the District; (3) the applicant agrees to enter into an agreement with the District to allow for the ongoing measurement of water levels in the well; (4) the applicant must submit a copy of TCEQ's preliminary approval related to the engineering and design of the well; (5) the well must be completed through the Twin Mountains portion of the Trinity Aquifer and cemented from the top of that formation to the surface; and (6) the well's production capacity must not exceed what is stated in the application. Director Watts seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- 2. President Mesler adjourned the Public Hearing for City of Willow Park at 5:10 p.m.
- 3. Mayor Bob Cornett of City of Cresson, Raul Sanchez, and Zuri Franco participated in the discussion regarding a new well application and an application for exception to District spacing requirements submitted by City of Cresson in Parker County. Director Watts moved to approve a new well application and an application for exception to District spacing requirements submitted by City of Cresson in Parker County with the following conditions: (1) once selected, the well drilling contractor must complete and sign the portion of the applications related to well driller; (2) an electric/geophysical log shall be completed related to the well, and the applicant will submit all such logs to the District; (3) the applicant agrees to enter into an agreement with the District to allow for the ongoing measurement of water levels in the well; (4) the applicant must submit a copy of TCEQ's preliminary approval related to the engineering and design of the well;. Director English moved to authorize (contingent upon approval by District's Legal Counsel) the General Manager to offer an initial \$250 settlement, then up to \$50 per day thereafter, to settle any violation of District Rule 3.11(b)(3), in lieu of litigation. Director Berkley seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

- 4. No new business was placed on the next meeting agenda.
- 5. Public comment was heard where noted above.
