
1. _____ Will the project offset current groundwater use? – *25 total points*
 - a. Yes – 25 points
 - b. Not currently, but will replace the need to drill a well – 10 points

2. _____ Will the applicant cost share any portion of the project? – *20 total points*
 - a. 75% - 20 points
 - b. 50 % - 10 points
 - c. 25% - 5 points
 - d. 0% - 0 total points

3. _____ Will water collected from the project be made available to fire departments/Emergency Service Districts? – *15 total points*
 - a. Yes – 15 points

4. _____ Will the public have access to visit the project site after completion? – *20 total points*
 - a. Yes – if yes, what is an estimate of number of annual visitors to the project site?
 - i. 1-100 – 2 points

Part 2: Applicant Interview

Possible Total Points = 25

Based on the number of applications received, the Committee in its sole discretion will determine if it plans to interview all applicants or only one or more of the top-scoring applicants. A total of 25 points based on the overall benefit of the project to the District in carrying out its purposes may be awarded pursuant to the interview.

* Regardless of the total points awarded to an application, or the total points received in relation to the total points received by any other applications that were submitted to the District, the District's board of directors will not award any funds to an application unless the board determines that: (1) the approved funding will serve and accomplish a public purpose of the District; (2) the District will have sufficient controls to ensure that the expenditure is used for the public purpose intended, and (3) that the District will receive a clear benefit from the expenditure that is commensurate with the level of funding approved.
